

Connie Flanagan is a professor of youth civic development in the Department of Agricultural and Extension Education at Penn State University where she co-directs the inter-college minor in Civic and Community Engagement. Dr. Flanagan's program of research concerns young people's theories about the social contract, i.e., their views of the rights and responsibilities that bind members of society together, and the factors in families, schools, and community based organizations that promote civic values and competencies in young people. Dr. Flanagan is a member of Penn State's Public Scholarship Associates, a group of faculty from across the university who are committed to developing the civic competencies and commitments of students. Currently Dr. Flanagan is a member of the MacArthur Network on Transition to Adulthood and a fellow in Penn State's Rock Ethics Institute.
